

CLINICAL LABS SHOULD SUBMIT APPLICATION FOR GOVERNMENT LICENSE BY OCT. 1, 1968

The Clinical Laboratories Improvement Act of 1967 will become effective Jan. 1, 1969. The law requires that clinical laboratories soliciting or accepting specimens in interstate commerce be licensed by the Secretary of the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare.

Although some laboratories will qualify for exemption, each clinical laboratory in interstate commerce is required to submit an application for licensure.
